Vandemoortele can rightfully claim to literally be a 'household name', as its margarines, oils, donuts, pastry and patisserie products find their way into just about everyone's life under its own brands, including Belolive, Diamant, Reddy, Ossewit, Banquet d'Or and Croustifrance. In addition, there are many Vandemoortele products that are not marketed to consumers under these brand names, but are instead delivered under private labels to professional users, retail customers and supermarkets.

Streamlining and optimizing

Handling well over a thousand design changes per year in packaging, Vandemoortele needs to be in perfect control of its artwork, data and workflow at all times. To achieve this, the Belgium-based company, with operations in 12 European countries, opted for Esko WebCenter in 2012. Nico Schenk, Packaging Specialist at Vandemoortele Nederland, has been responsible for the implementation of WebCenter. He comments, "Today, we have a total of some 450 people using our customized system – including the external users at the suppliers that we work with, such as repro houses or printers."

Rethinking approval cycles

Schenk joined the Vandemoortele Group in 2009. Previously, there had been a number of acquisitions of companies and brands. "This made for a complex environment and clearly required us to rethink the way we handled artwork for our brands and for our customers' private label brands – the latter comprising about 70 percent of our portfolio. When you have several hundred people that are in some way involved with this process, it is easy to lose track during any approval cycle. To prevent this from happening, you need to ensure availability of the right information and data at all times and have clear responsibilities and accountability for all people involved. Esko WebCenter enables us to do exactly that."

Approval tool ideal for fast decisionmaking

Every new or revised piece of packaging at Vandemoortele is handled through WebCenter, Schenk explains. Depending upon the required approval cycle for the job, a predefined flow is automatically set up for the project, including tasks and deadlines. WebCenter users are assigned to the project and given responsibility for checking details in their field of expertise. These include areas such as updates to nutritional or legal texts or design elements that affect technical production requirements. These users are notified automatically by the system to ensure the tasks are completed in time and nothing is overlooked.

Ensure efficiency and continuity

Faster approval cycles greatly impact Vandemoortele's operations, says Schenk: "Let me give you an example. At our Zeewolde facilities in The Netherlands, we produced over 70 million tubs of various types of margarine for different brands last year. To ensure efficiency and continuity, we plan our production according to our customers' yearly forecasted needs. Based on these forecasts, we order our packaging, allowing our suppliers to produce stock for a maximum of 13 weeks ahead. These planning schedules are important to keep in mind when we need to anticipate any changes to the product or the packaging. By ordering at exactly the right moment, we can minimize any under- or overstocking and save waste and costs. Esko WebCenter allows us to keep approval cycles for the necessary changes in artwork in line with production cycles, without missing any important deadlines."
